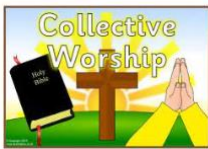

Chasing outstanding money owed to the school causes considerable extra work for office staff and embarrassment for all concerned.

SAFEGUARDING

At Baldwins Gate Primary School we have a moral and legal duty to keep all our children safe from harm. Harm which can hinder the development of a child can be physical abuse, emotional abuse, neglect and sexual abuse.

Where we have concerns in any area we will talk firstly to the child. If we have cause to be concerned, we will make our concerns known to the First Response team at Staffordshire County Council. It will then be their responsibility to investigate further.

Please do not be offended in any way if a member of staff approaches you or discusses a concern with you. Equally if you have any concerns or require any support, please speak to your child's class teacher or one of our safeguarding leads.

SICKNESS AND DIARRHOEA

A reminder of the school's policy with regard to sickness and diarrhoea. A child who has sickness or diarrhoea whilst at school is to be collected immediately and **kept away until 48 hours following their last case of sickness and/or diarrhoea.** If a child reports that they have had sickness and/or diarrhoea whilst at home, the school will contact the parent. If the parent confirms that this is the case, they will be asked to collect their child immediately. This 48 hour rule is essential in order to protect other students or staff from contracting a bug. Unfortunately, this may mean that a student misses a school event.

CHICKENPOX IN SCHOOL

We continue to have a few cases of chickenpox. The most noticeable symptom for chickenpox is an itchy skin rash with red blisters. There are also other symptoms of chickenpox that parents should be aware of, which may appear before or after the rash:

- a high temperature
- aches and pains, headache, and generally feeling unwell
- loss of appetite

Information regarding chickenpox is available on the NHS website [NHS Guidance](#). Children with chickenpox should be kept at home until all the spots have crusted over. This is usually about five days after the spots first appeared.

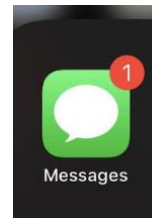

TEXT MESSAGES FROM SCHOOL

From time to time, we send information via text message to your mobile phone. We can send messages to you for free using the School Gateway App, which is available for you to download.



Please download the app to your phone to ensure you receive all messages.

The set-up process is simple and will take no more than a couple of minutes:

1. Search for “School Gateway” in the Apple App Store/Google Play or on your phone go to www.schoolgateway.com/apple (Apple) or www.schoolgateway.com/android (Android)

2. Install the app and if you are asked then say yes to “Allow Push Notifications”

3. When you launch School Gateway for the first time, please select ‘New User’ and enter the email address and mobile telephone number you have registered with the school

4. The system will send a PIN code to your phone; please enter this PIN code and the app will be activated for you.

As soon as you’ve got the system set-up, all of the text messages we send you will appear in the app; you’ll receive notifications/alerts as normal.

If you’ve recently changed your email address or mobile telephone number, please let us know so we can update our records.

PARKING
